

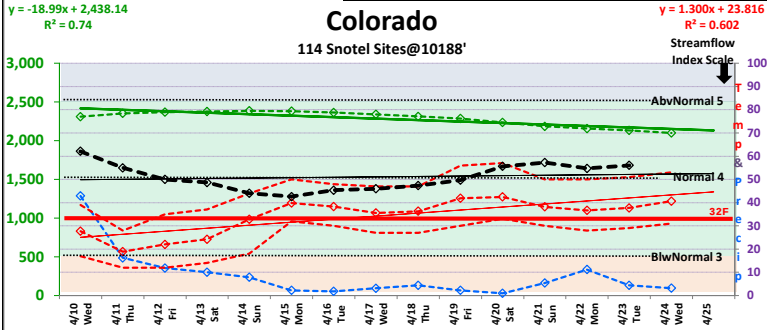

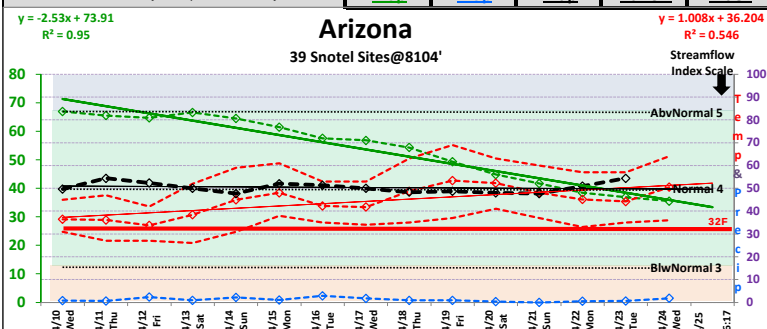
Two Week SNOTEL and USGS State Plots of

NRCS SNOTEL Temperatures(Min, Average with Trendline, Max), Precipitation and SWE with Trendline

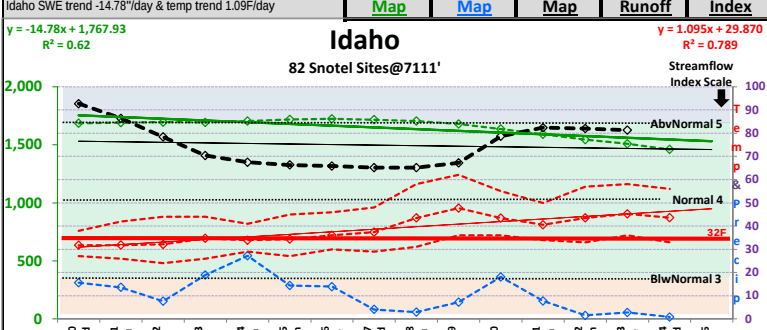
Colorado SWE trend -18.99"/day & temp trend 1.30F/day



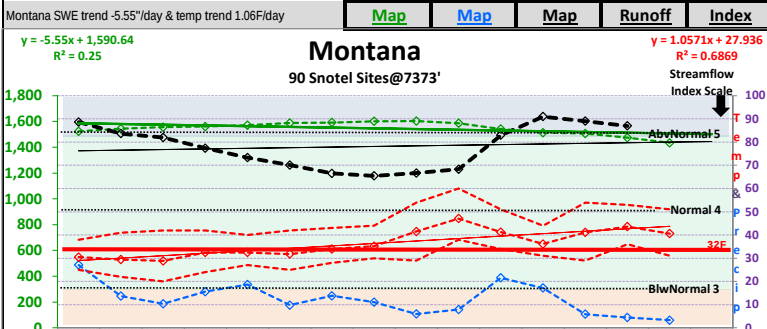
Arizona SWE trend -2.53"/day & temp trend 1.01F/day



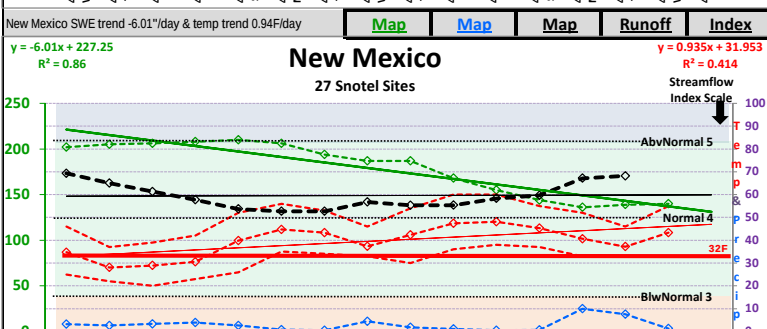
Idaho SWE trend -14.78"/day & temp trend 1.09F/day



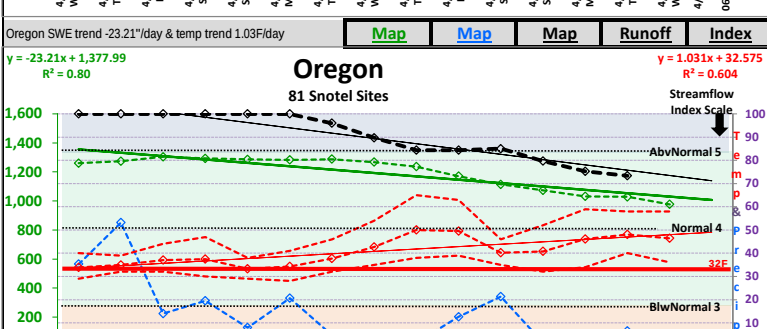

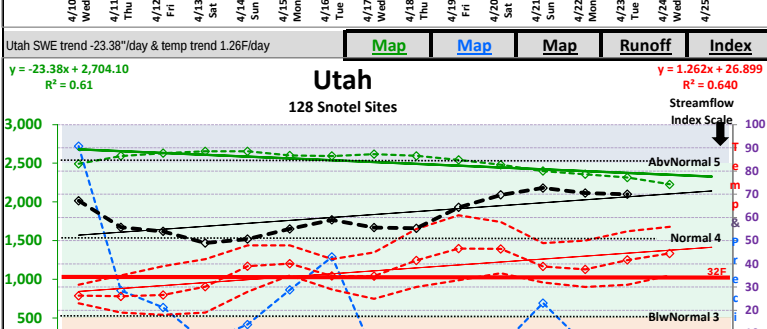

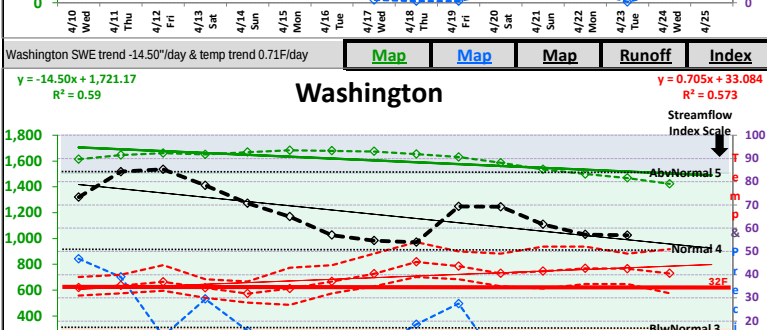

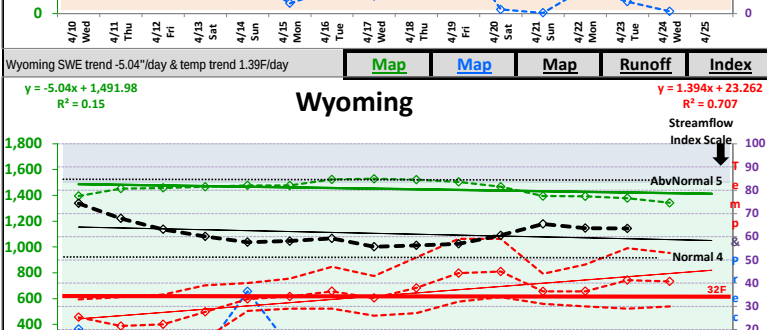

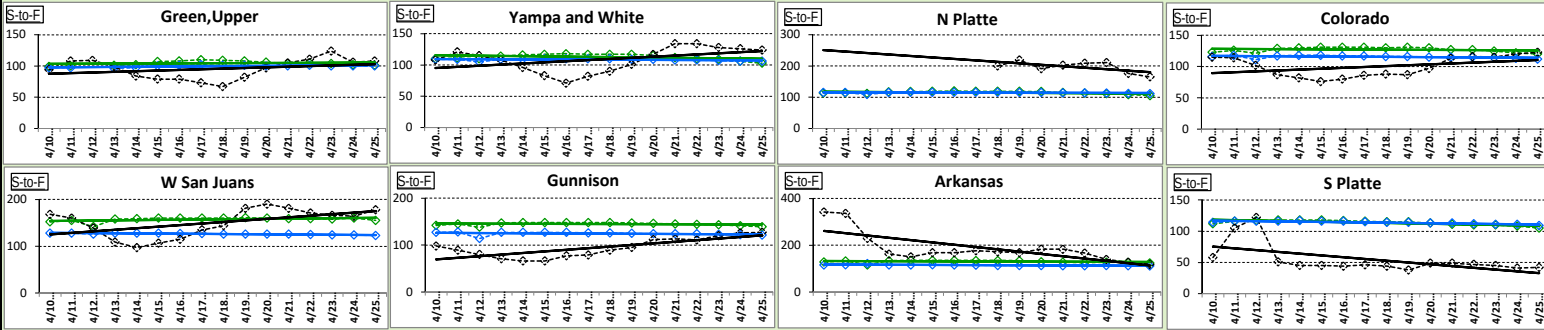
